## a/an + Noun

(1) A noun is a word that names a person, animal, place, or thing.
(2) The words a and an usually come before singular nouns. A is placed before consonant sounds, and an before vowel sounds.

| a | a cat | a girl | a hat | a pen | a school |
| :---: | :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| an | an apple | an egg | an igloo | an octopus | an umbrella |
