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

I am = I'm	We <b>are</b> = We <b>'re</b>	
You <b>are</b> = You' <b>re</b>	You <b>are</b> = You <b>'re</b>	
She/He/It <b>is</b> = She <b>'s</b> /He <b>'s</b> /It <b>'s</b>	They <b>are</b> = They <b>'re</b>






She is not a nurse. She is a doctor.

They aren't books. They're albums.




