- ① The verb to be shows the state of being, and it has three forms: am, are, is.
- 2 The negative form is be + not, and the yes/no question form is "Be + subject ...?"

Affirmative	Negative	Question
I am a student.	I am not a student.	Am I a student?
You are a student.	You are not a student.	Are you a student?
She/He/It is a student.	She/He/It is not a student.	Is she/he/it a student?
We/You/They are students.	We/You/They are not students.	Are we/you/they students?

③ Contractions for pronoun + be and be + not

I'm	She's	He's	It's	We're	You're	They're
I'm not	She's not	He's not	It's not	We're not	You're not	They're not


