#### Singular and Plural Nouns

A singular noun expresses one person, one animal, one place, or one thing. A plural noun expresses two or more people, animals, places, or things. Plural nouns usually end in -s or -es.

	Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural	
-s	house	houses	tree	trees	•To make most nouns plural, add <b>-s</b> .
-es	beach glass	beaches glasses	brush fox	brushes foxes	<ul><li>Noun ending: -ch, -sh, -s, -x</li><li>Plural form: Add -es.</li></ul>
-ies	city fly	cities flies	family story	families stories	<ul> <li>Noun ending: a consonant + -y</li> <li>Plural form: Change y to i and add -es.</li> </ul>
-ves	leaf thief	leaves thieves	knife wolf	knives wolves	<ul> <li>Noun ending: -f or -fe</li> <li>Plural form: Change f or fe to v and add -es.</li> </ul>
Irregular	mouse	mice	sheep	sheep	•No rules

#### **B** Count and Non-Count Nouns

- ① Count nouns can be counted with numbers. They have singular and plural forms.
- ② Non-count nouns cannot be counted with numbers. They have singular forms only. Do not use **a** or **an** with non-count nouns.

#### Articles: A/An and The

① Use **a** or **an** with singular nouns. Put **a** before a consonant and **an** before a vowel.

I have a bag. I have an umbrella.
