Spelling Squares



What You Need

- 2 players
- game mat
- fine-point dry erase markers

Directions

1. Trade spelling lists with a partner.
2. Take turns giving each other a word to spell aloud.
3. When a player spells a word correctly, he uses a dry erase marker to write it in a space on his side of the game mat. Then he connects a pair of dots with a straight line. The line can go up and down or across. No slanted lines! Players should try to make boxes by connecting the dots. When a player makes a line that closes a box, he writes his initials in the box.
4. If a player misses a word, he loses a turn. His partner then spells the word aloud and shows it to him.
5. Play until all the words on each player's list have been used at least once. The player with the most boxes at the end of the game wins!
