Write, Check

- **5** Write the word.
- **6** Check your spelling.

- **Check** your words with your teacher. Listen to your teacher say the word. Say the word aloud.

- **5 Listen** to your teacher spell the word.
- 6 **Put** a check above each correct letter. Circle a letter that is not correct.
- 7 Write each misspelled word correctly. Say the word. Say each letter out loud.

Word Sorting

A word sort helps you see how words are the same. The words hat, sat, and mat go together in a word sort. They all have the letters at. Word sorting can help you remember how to spell words.

There are different kinds of word sorts you can use with your spelling words.

- Individual Sort—Sort your words by yourself.
- Buddy Sort—Sort with a partner.
- Speed Sorts on Your Own—Time yourself as you sort your words.
 Then start over and try to get faster!
- **Speed Sorts With a Team**—See which team can sort the fastest and with the most right answers.
