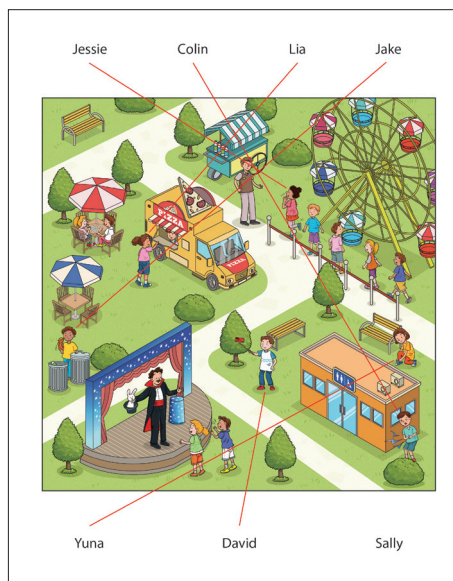

Hello. This is the Cambridge English Movers Listening Prep Test.

Look at Part 1. Now look at the picture.
Listen and look. There is one example.

BOY: Grandma, look at this photo.
I went to a fair last weekend.

WOMAN: Wow! It looks really fun.
What did you do at the fair, David?

BOY: I took a selfie.

WOMAN: Oh, there you are!

Can you see the line? This is an example.
Now you listen and draw lines.

BOY: Lia really likes pizza.

WOMAN: Does she? Where is she in the photo?

BOY: She's ordering pizza from the food truck.
She's wearing the pink T-shirt.

WOMAN: Oh, I see her.

WOMAN: Oh, no. He looks sick.

BOY: Who?

WOMAN: The boy next to the restroom.

BOY: Oh, that's Colin.
He had a stomachache that day.

WOMAN: Poor boy. I hope he feels better now.

BOY: Jessie doesn't like taking pictures.

WOMAN: Really? Then what did she do at the fair?

BOY: Jessie rode the Ferris Wheel.

Look, she's waiting in the line.

WOMAN: Oh, there she is. She looks excited.

BOY: Yes, she does.

Jessie is next in line for the Ferris Wheel!

WOMAN: Who's that boy wearing the yellow T-shirt?

BOY: The boy putting trash in the trash can?

WOMAN: Yes.

BOY: He's Jake.

He never throws trash on the ground.

WOMAN: What a nice boy!

WOMAN: What is she doing?

BOY: Who, Grandma?

WOMAN: The girl behind the restroom.

Is she sitting on the grass?

BOY: No, she isn't. Her name is Yuna.

She's tying her shoes.

WOMAN: Ah, I see.

BOY: I love swimming. It's my favorite sport.

Where is the swimming pool?

BOY: It's across from the bookstore.

GIRL: Really? Across from the bookstore?

BOY: Yes. It's not that far.

BOY: I go there on foot.

GIRL: On foot? How long does it take to walk?

BOY: It takes about 15 minutes.

GIRL: That's not too bad.

BOY: No, but my sister does. It's her hobby.

GIRL: That's so cool!

Can you see the letter A?

Now you listen and write a letter in each box.

GIRL: Well, what does he like to do?

BOY: My brother likes to learn Spanish.

He wants to travel to Spain one day.

GIRL: Your grandpa bakes cookies?
BOY: Yes, he likes to bake cookies on weekends.

MAN: Hi, Lana. My name is Mr. Smith.
GIRL: Hello, Mr. Smith. How are you?
MAN: I'm great. Thank you.
Lana, where are you from?
GIRL: I'm from Australia. I'm Australian.

GIRL: Eric, what a surprise! What are you doing here?
BOY: I'm looking for a book.
GIRL: What kind of book?
BOY: I'm looking for a book about animals.

Part 5 Look at the picture.

Listen and look. There is one example.

BOY: What's this?
WOMAN: This is a picture of a shopping center.
Can you see the man with a T-shirt?
BOY: Yes, I can. He's drinking water.
WOMAN: Great. Let's color his T-shirt blue.

Can you see the man's blue T-shirt?

This is an example.

Now you listen and color and write.

WOMAN: Who? The woman sitting on the bench?
BOY: Yes. Is she eating a pretzel?
WOMAN: Yes, she is. Color her dress yellow.
BOY: OK. I'm coloring it yellow.
