

### Jungle Phonics 1

Here is a sample lesson plan for the main units below. Actual lesson plans for class can vary depending on the course's weekly schedule, daily time allotment, students' school grades, and their ages. Teachers can cover one main unit for two days.

#### ◆ Main units ◆

[Day 1]

For Day 1, teachers should mainly focus on **Listen, point, and repeat** so that students can fully understand and pronounce the words they are learning.

[Day 2]

For Day 2, teachers should quickly go over the target sound words they learned in Day 1 and spend more time with **Story** and **Activity** to practice the target sounds.

## ◆ Review units ◆

In review units, leave enough time for students to fully understand what they learned in the previous class.

| 5 min | <u>The 1st page of the review units</u><br>Listen and circle<br>Listen, write, and match | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have students listen to the words that have the target sound and help them to read out the words as much as they can in class</li> <li>• Give students opportunities to say words in pairs or in groups without teacher's help to see whether or not they can pronounce various sounds appropriately</li> <li>• Teachers can get more information on how to teach for each exercise from the teaching tips found in the Teacher's Guide</li> </ul> |
| 5 min | <u>The 2nd page of the review units</u><br>Read and circle<br>Look and write             |   |
| 5 min | <u>The 3rd page of the review units</u><br>Say and circle<br>Say, match, and write       |   |
| 5 min | Story  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have students read out the story</li> <li>• Watch the video clip of the story</li> <li>• Practice reading and let students know the quiz answers</li> </ul>  |
| 5 min | Activity   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Prepare some possible activities</li> <li>• Explain activities and play as a class<br/>(If needed, divide the whole class into groups to have activities)</li> </ul>   |
| 5 min | Wrap-up  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wind up the lesson</li> </ul>  |
