How to Play

WHAT YOU NEED: game pieces

1. Play rock-paper-scissors to decide who goes first.
2. The student who wins closes their eyes and points to a number in the middle of the board. Then the student moves the game piece.
[No. 1] Move forward 1 space. [No. 2] Move forward 2 spaces.
[No. 3] Move forward 3 spaces. [Point] Try again.
3. Say the word where the game piece lands. Then say the matching sentence using the same colored box.
4. The student who finishes first wins the game.
