





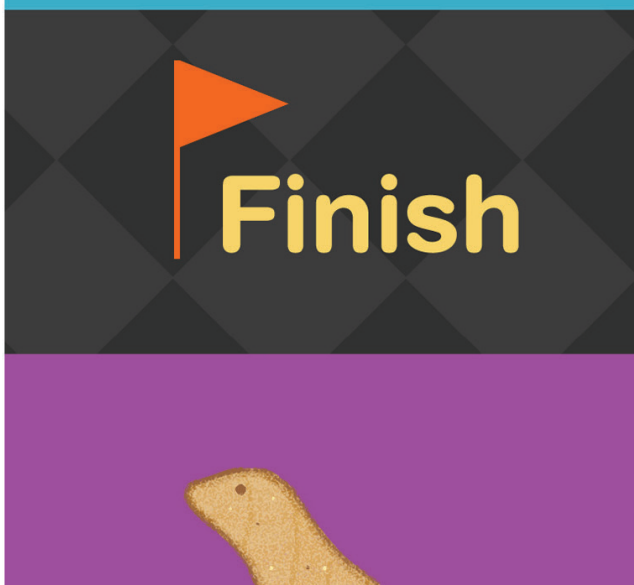


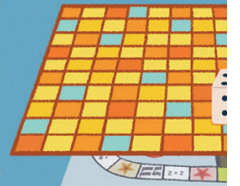
# How to Play

4. The student who finishes first wins the game.

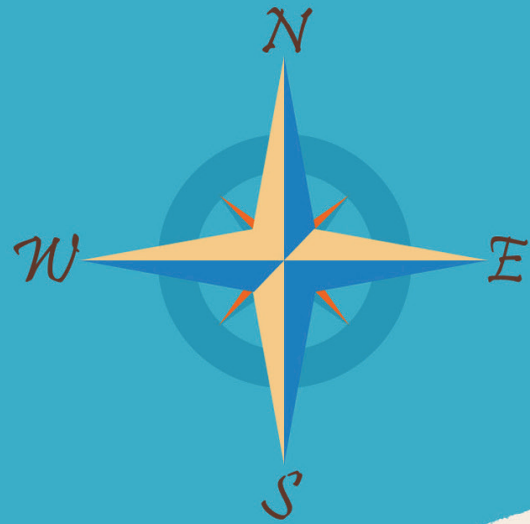
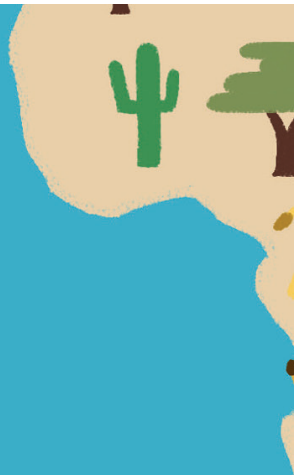

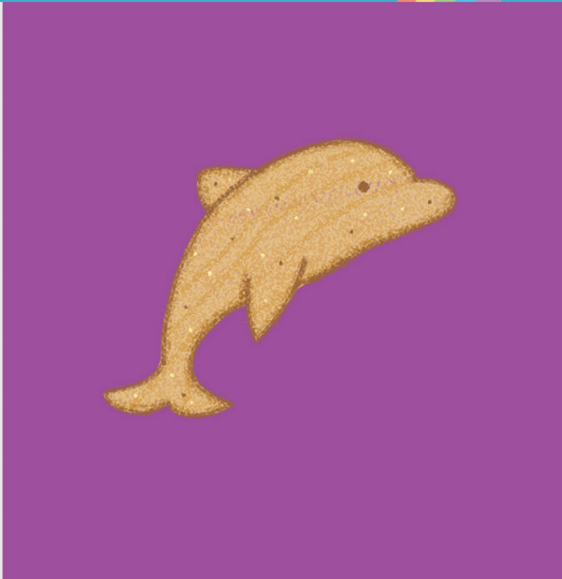
