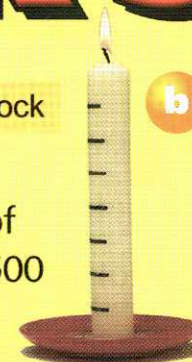

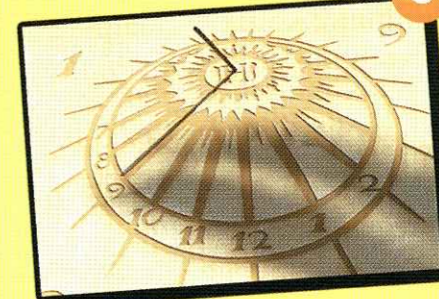

Sabina Superhero



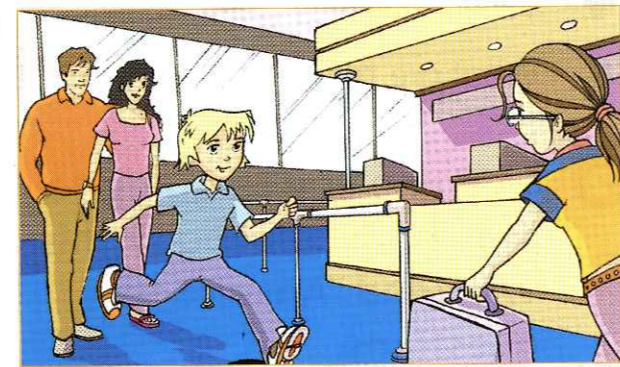

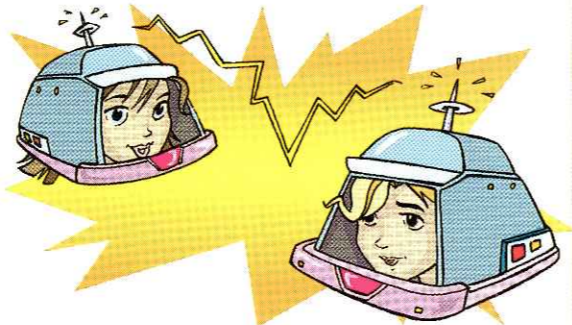
