





stomachs. Some
snakes can swim,
and some snakes can
fly, but many snakes
can climb trees.

Snakes use two things to climb trees. They use their bodies. They push hard against the tree. It is very difficult for them to do, and they take a long time. They are not very fast climbers.

Snakes also use their scales. Scales are small, hard pieces on a snake's skin. Some snake scales are smooth and flat. Other snake scales are not smooth. They are rough. Scales that are rough can stick to tree bark, so the snake can hold on better.


