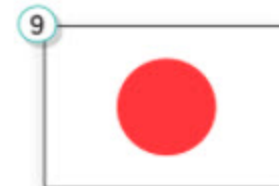

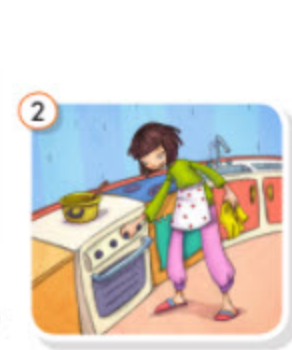

Mexico has corn tortilla pizza. To make it, first, spread beans on the pizza. Next, add cheese and vegetables. Then bake it in the oven. After that, you can add tomatoes and olives. You can also put sauce on it.

Turkey has a pizza called *lahmacun*. It has beef but not cheese. To make it, first, chop some parsley and other vegetables. Next, fry the beef. Then put them on the pizza and bake it in the oven.



In New York City, there are dessert pizzas. You make them with chocolate and sugar. You can add sweet sauce and fruit to them. These pizzas aren't very healthy, but they taste good.
