### Example:


Student A: Number one. I have a ball.




Students A and B: Keep your pictures secret. Take turns to describe your pictures.


### Example:

Student A: Number one. I have a ball. Student B: I don't have a ball. I have a computer.




















Students A and B: Find another pair. Shuffle all cards into one pack. Give six cards to each player.
