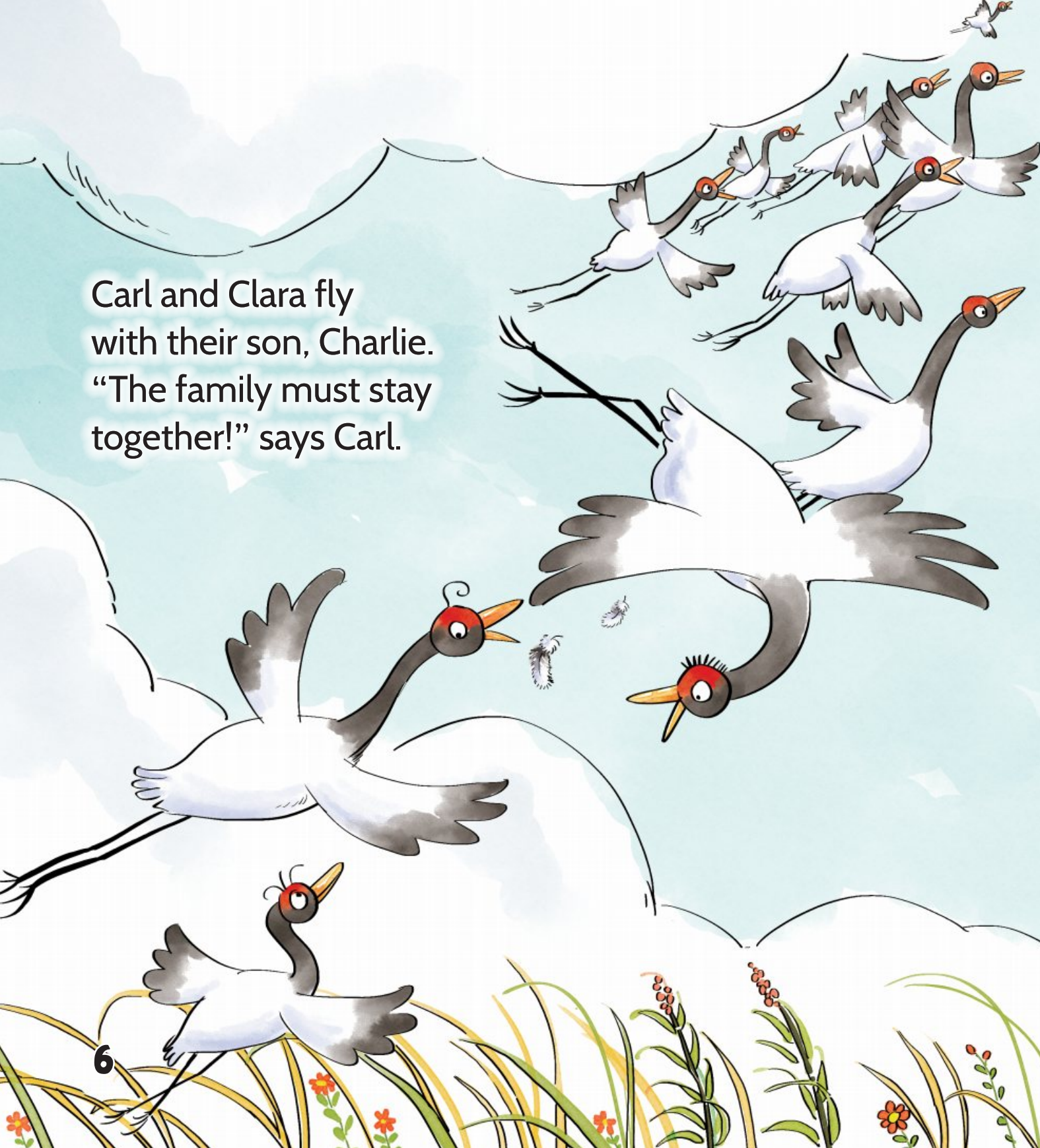
The white cranes have a nice summer by the cold water lake. Now autumn comes.

A red giant lived in the big mountains near a village. He was strong and he loved showing off.

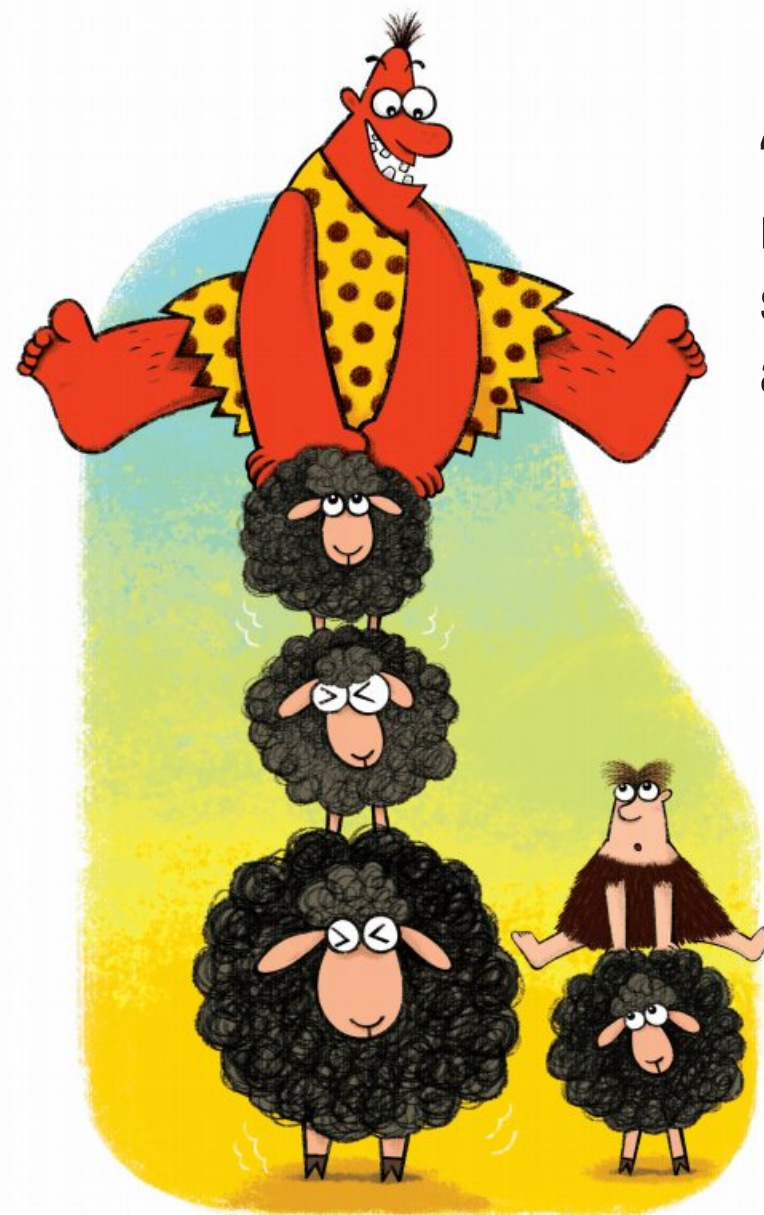


One day, there was a village fair. "I'll show them how strong I am!" the red giant thought. So he went to the fair.

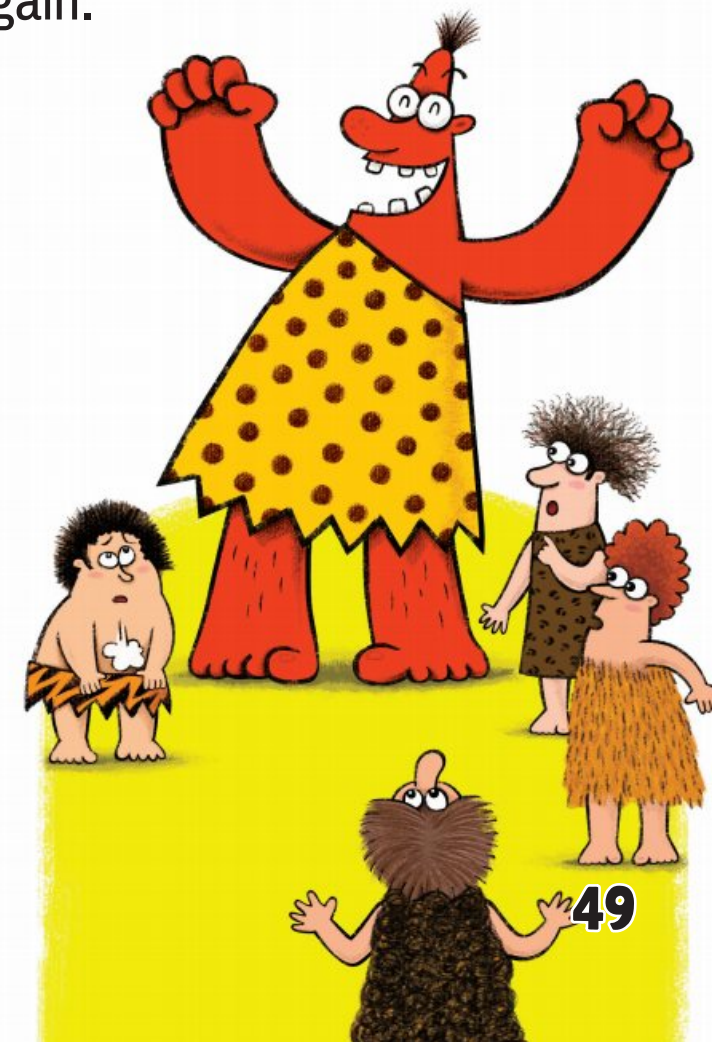


Some villagers were having a running race. The giant ran with them and won. "No one's faster than me. I'm the fastest!" He showed off to the villagers.

Then the red giant jumped in the high jump race. He won.

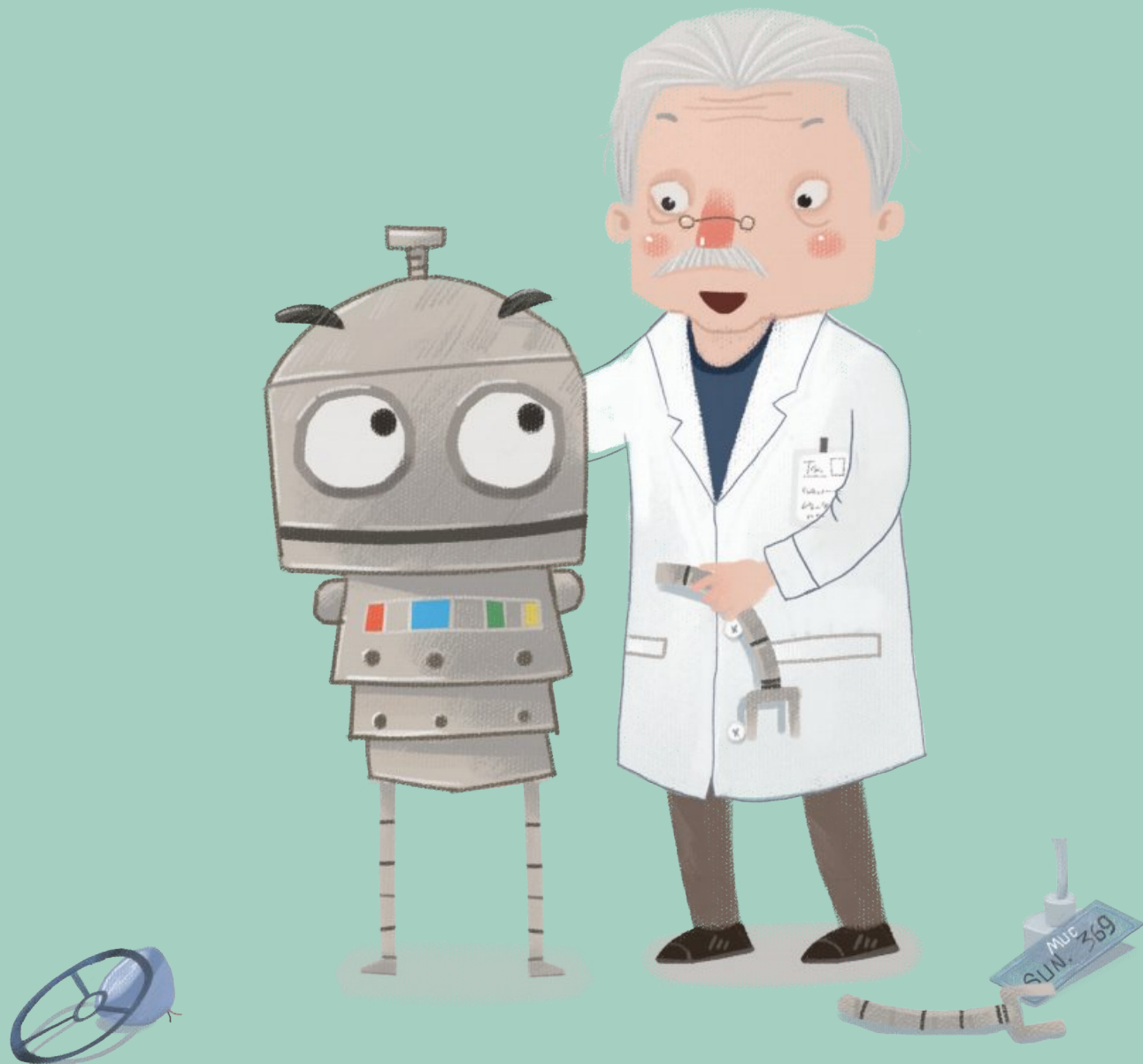


"No one jumps higher than me. I jump the highest!" He showed off to the villagers again.
