




Frogs are amphibians.

Bodies


Frogs have four legs with webbed toes. Frogs do not have tails.



Food


Frogs eat different kinds of food.

Life Cycle


Frogs' bodies change shape as they grow. A tadpole does not look like a grown-up frog.


