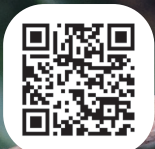

Cats show their feelings when they meow and purr. But they mainly use body language to show their feelings to humans and other cats.

A high tail means the cat is in a **friendly** mood. It also means the cat feels relaxed and happy. But be careful when the tail is low. The cat might be **nervous**, **scared**, or angry.

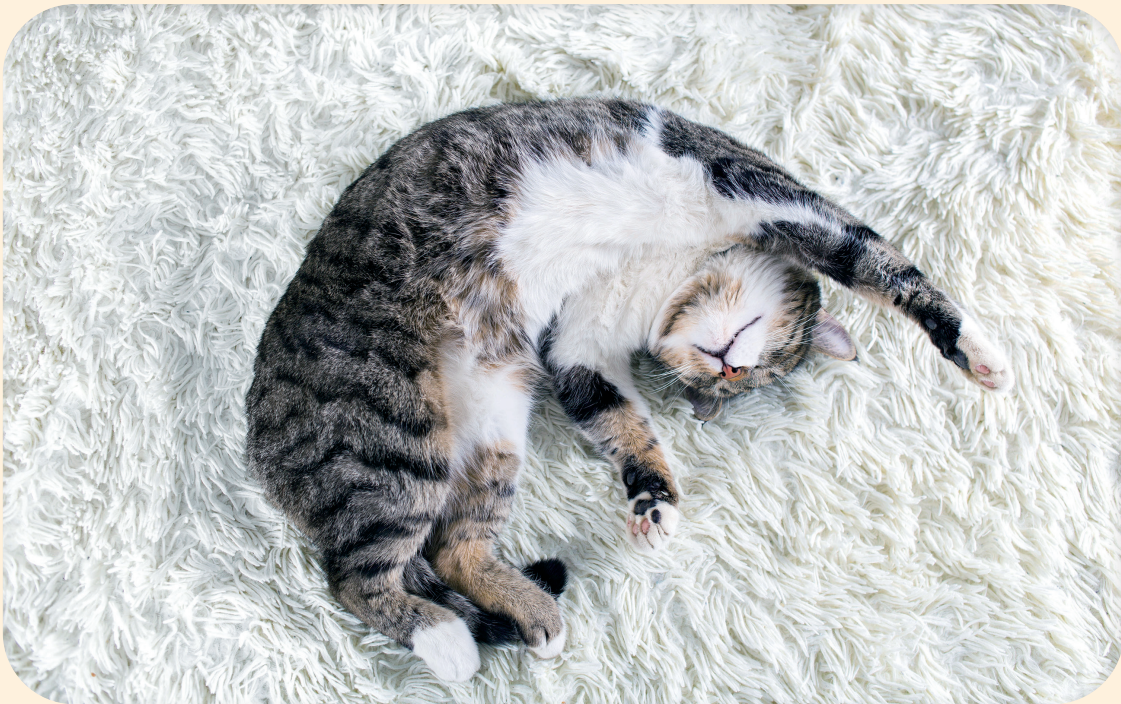


Let's Discover

How do cats show their feelings?



Cats show their feelings with their ears too. A happy cat's ears are often facing forward. A scared cat's ears are turned sideways. And an angry cat's ears are **flattened** against their head.



Cats sometimes roll over and show their **belly**. When we can see their belly, we know they love and trust us. But should we **pet** their belly? Maybe not. Some cats might like it. But some do not!

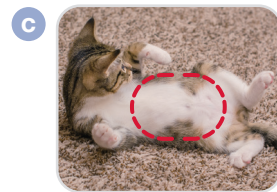
