

Warming Earth

Today's global warming is happening too fast. And sadly, it is mainly caused by human activities. For example, the cars we drive and machines we use release greenhouse gases into the air. These greenhouse gases trap **heat** and speed up global warming. As temperatures go up, **glaciers** melt and sea levels **rise**. This puts coastal cities in danger of flooding.




