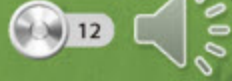


Turnip Soup

The cat gets the rat. They all pull together. Victory! They eat turnip soup.



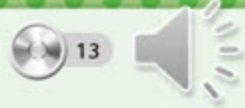

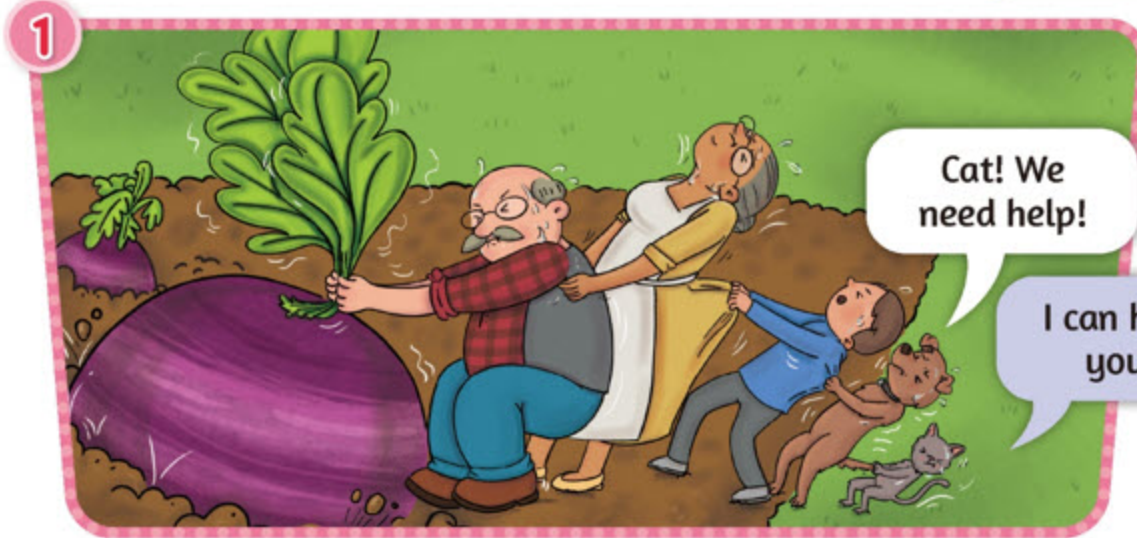
