







On the table, there is a chicken and a violin. They are special.















Jack steals the chicken and the violin. The violin shouts.



Jack runs out with the chicken and the violin. The giant wakes up. He is mad.




Jack goes down the beanstalk. He shouts to his mom.




What should I do, Jack?
